It is communicated that National Leprosy Eradication Programme (NLEP) from 2016 onward has been strengthened in a phased manner through introduction of more than a dozen innovations/ initiatives, such as Leprosy Case Detection Campaign (LCDC), Sparsh Leprosy Awareness Campaign (SLAC), Focussed Leprosy Campaign (FLC), ASHA based Surveillance for Leprosy Suspects (ABSULS) etc. due to which early detection of leprosy cases has increased and Grade II disability (G2D) has receded significantly.

This VC will help in programme monitoring, supportive supervision, feedback & better liaisoning. It will support the efforts being made by this division to achieve Leprosy Free India by 2030.
